

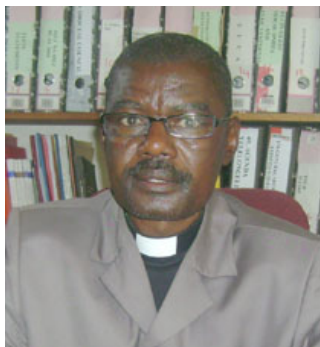

On October 1st the NJ Synod welcomes Pastor Eliakim Shaanika, General Secretary of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Namibia (ELCIN).

Pastor Shaanika will spend four weeks with four congregations in our synod. We give thanks to St John, Ocean City (Oct 1-8); Christ, Whiting (Oct 8-15); St Stephen, Woodbury (Oct 15-22); Good Shepherd, Somerville (Oct 22-29) for hosting Pastor Shaanika.



While here he will tell the story of work and mission of the ELCIN, share parish ministry with the congregations he visits, articulate his personal faith story and where occasion permits he will have opportunity to preach and to teach.

2010 MISSION TRIP
June 14-29, 2010

GOAL OF THE VISIT: Participants will visit with church leaders, congregations, ministries, and agencies of our companions in Christ: The Lutheran Churches in Namibia. Establish or reaffirm sister congregation relationships and visits with leaders, schools, rural mission stations, health facilities, craft projects, with a visit to Etosha Pan Park Reserve in Northern Namibia will form the itinerary.

COST: Approximately \$3,750, depending on airfare and accommodations. Participants will be housed in double or triple occupancy rooms in retreat centers, guest houses, and modest hotels. All meals are provided.
