What is Passing on Vibrant Faith?

Passing on Vibrant Faith is the name for a congregational renewal initiative (previously called Passing On Faith, which was previously called Child In Our Hands) set forth by Vibrant Faith Ministries (formerly the Youth & Family Institute), an ELCA-based who:

equips congregations, households, and individuals to live a vibrant faith in Jesus Christ and share the Christian faith among all generations.

At its heart, Passing on Vibrant Faith is about three things:

1. Strengthening the role of home as church.
2. Partnering home and congregation to better pass on faith from generation to generation.
3. Gather all the generations of the church to pass on the faith.
