Required musical competencies

- Proficiency on organ and piano.
- Excellent sight-reading ability.
- High choral standards and experience rehearsing and conducting both amateur and professional singers.
- Proficiency in a broad range of musical styles.
- Adequate vocal skills to demonstrate in rehearsals.
- Familiarity with and appreciation for handbell choirs.

Preferred musical competencies

- Singing skills adequate for *leading* worship.
- Liturgical music experience.
- Advanced skills in playing and directing hand bells.
- Basic skills on at least two other instruments.
- Composing and arranging experience.
- Teaching experience in basic music theory.

Organizational Accountability and Responsibility

The DIRECTOR OF MUSIC shall:

- Work under the supervision of the pastor and be responsible to the pastor and the Congregational Council.
- Attend weekly staff meetings.
- Cooperate with the pastor and the Worship and Music Committee in the areas of general planning and leadership of the music program.
- Set an example of ministry, collegiality, professionalism, and care toward others.
- Empower people in the congregation and wider community to share their musical gifts.

Professional Qualifications

- We seek a candidate grounded in the Christian tradition who will use music to enrich the congregation's expression of faith.
- Experience with and an openness to incorporating diverse genres in the worship experiences.
- Bachelor's degree preferred in music or related field.
- Familiarity with liturgical worship, preferably in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America.

Administrative Responsibility, Functions and Duties

- Provide music (organ, piano, choir and/or special music) for the current worship schedule and Christian holidays (one Saturday night service, one Sunday morning service, and one interactive online Sunday evening service).
- Provide leadership, coordination and rehearsal schedules for all adult and children's vocal and bell choirs and instrumental ensembles.
- Provide leadership and/or coordinate a comprehensive music program for children of all ages.
- Perform or provide music for all other rites (weddings/funerals).

Salary, Vacation, And Other Conditions

- Salary commensurate with education and experience.
