The congregational council communicates its recommendation to the congregation and makes the updated constitution available for review by members at least 30 days prior to the congregational meeting.

At the duly called congregational meeting voting members approve only the "conformity" changes to the constitution as listed. A simple majority is required to move forward.

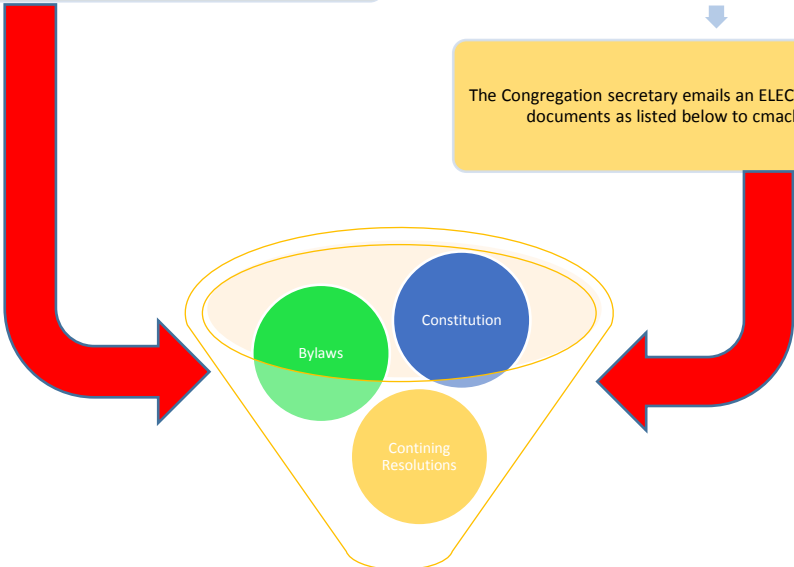
