## Dear Colleagues,

I am writing to bring your attention to a matter related to the Boy Scouts of America. As you may be aware, the Boy Scouts of America has filed for bankruptcy earlier this year, primarily due to the number of sexual abuse lawsuits. There are many questions about what this may mean for congregations that are (or were) chartering organizations for Boy Scout troops. In particular, congregations that chartered Boy Scout troops, at any time in their history, should consider whether to file a proof of claim in the bankruptcy to protect their interests.

The ELCA has prepared an FAQ document to help you determine whether to file such a claim. You can find that document
